

## Terms of participation

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### ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be made in accordance with the terms of participation.

2. Online Entry - To enter into the "Strawberry Showcase", please go to [www.KrazyKup.com/talentshow](http://www.KrazyKup.com/talentshow) and follow the prompts. Each act is required to submit a video audition in order to be considered for the live audition dates. Upload your video audition to a service such as Youtube or Vimeo and supply the required URL link within the entry form. If selected for one of our live audition dates you will be contacted to schedule a date and time. A \$25 entry fee will be collected at the time of your live audition. Payments can be made using card or cash when you arrive. The entry fees collected will go towards the total cash prizes available for contestants.

## **Competition Format**

### **Strawberry Showcase 2019**

1. Five acts will be selected as finalists at each live audition date for a total of 15 finalists, those finalists will be narrowed to a top 10 to take part in the final competition. The extra 5 finalists will act as alternates that will be called upon to perform in the final competition if one or more of the top 10 are unable to perform.
2. Acts will be judged on Presentation, Content, Originality and Proficiency.
3. Voting at the auditions and the final will be conducted by a panel of judges made up of local talent, business owners and community leaders.

## **CATEGORY GUIDELINES**

A) **Music** – solo male, female or group (2 or more performers, male or female): This category shall consist of a solo or group performance by a vocalist(s), instrumentalist(s) or any combination thereof. If accompaniment is used for a Rap or Vocalist performance the accompaniment must assume the pure character of accompaniment. The JUDGING shall be whether the performance would stand alone if the accompaniment were removed. If background vocals are present they must be at a minimal and in the case of a Rap artist the recording must not contain the majority of the lyrics on the accompaniment. Obscene & crude lyrics will be cause to disqualify.

B) **Dance** – solo male, female or group (2 or more performers, male or female): This category shall consist of a solo or group dance performance. Accompanists are permitted on stage. Ballet, pointe, tap, jazz, lyrical, modern, hip-hop, step, tumbling, clogging will be judged in this category. Please keep in mind that the performance space is limited at each audition location. We encourage you to visit the business location of your chosen audition date in order to better plan for your audition.

C) **Theater** – solo male, female or group (2 or more performers, male or female): This category shall consist of a solo or group performance of a comedy act, mime, skits, monologue, spoken word, etc. Please keep in mind that the performance space is limited at each audition location. We encourage you to visit the business location of your chosen audition date in order to better plan for your audition.

D) **Novelty** - solo male, female or group (2 or more performers, male or female): This category shall consist of a solo or group performance in any act that has not been previously described, such as yo yo, beat box, etc.

## JUDGING

1. A panel of three or more judges will serve at all live audition dates and the final competition.
2. Judging criteria will consist of the following:
  - A) Presentation
  - B) Content
  - C) Originality
  - D) Proficiency.
3. Awards will be presented at the end of the final competition.

## Terms

1. The "Strawberry Showcase" is organized in order to promote and encourage local performers to share their talent, connect with other talented individuals as well as connect local businesses that desire to partner with talented individuals in order to help them enhance their talent.
2. The competition is open to persons residing within 20 miles of Plant City.
3. Any act that has won an overall award in the "Strawberry Showcase" within the past 3 years is ineligible to participate **in the same category**.
4. Any reference to the "Strawberry Showcase" (SS) is deemed to include all members of the organising committee and its sponsors.
5. SS nor any individual member of the organising committee accept any responsibility for copyright issues pertaining to any act. It is the responsibility of the Artiste to seek permission for copyright from the copyright owner if required.
6. SS shall not be responsible for loss or damage to any property belonging to anyone involved in the competition.
7. All acts performances and materials should be done in a "family friendly" manner.

8. No hazardous liquids may be used, including naked flames.
9. No animals may be used in any act, without written consent from SS
10. All electrical equipment brought in by contestants must be in a safe condition and in good working order.
11. No sharp instruments, including swords, knives, axes, may be used in any acts.
12. No swearing/foul language or unsociable behaviour will be accepted.
13. All performers will act in a professional way throughout, being courteous to others and respect their needs at all times.
14. Any equipment used, which belongs to the organisers or venues, must be treated with respect and handled responsibly.
15. All breakages must be reported immediately and paid for.
16. All minors (those 17 years and under) must have signed permission from a parent/guardian on registration form granting their permission for them to participate in the show.
17. All minors must be accompanied by parent/guardian. In the event that a minor performs in the final no friends or relatives will be allowed backstage. Adequate chaperones will be provided.
18. Signing the registration form also grants the SS permission to use photographs/videos of the acts / artists on future publicity/media.
19. All acts must follow the entry procedure as laid down on the KrazyKup website and Facebook page.
20. All acts/artists must be available for sound checks/rehearsals as and when required by SS.
21. Each entrant will be given a time to audition and it is their responsibility to be in the holding area 10 minutes prior ready to perform. If an entrant misses their slot their entry will become void.
22. All entrants agree to be available to perform at the final: 7pm April 27th, 2019 at the 1914 High School Community Center located at 605 N Collins St, Plant City, FL 33563.
23. All technical requirements must be listed on the registration form, failure to do so may result in them being unavailable on the day.
24. Only named artist/acts listed on the registration form may be allowed to take part. If a substitute is required to enable the act to perform – prior permission must be sought from SS at the earliest possible moment.
25. Permission for acts/artists to perform is at the sole discretion of SS. No written discussion will be entered into. Their decision is final.
26. Video or audio recordings are not allowed by anyone other than SS staff/volunteers unless in a designated area where recordings are allowed. Video or audio recording is strictly prohibited backstage/green room or anywhere else designated solely for performers or staff/volunteers of SS.
