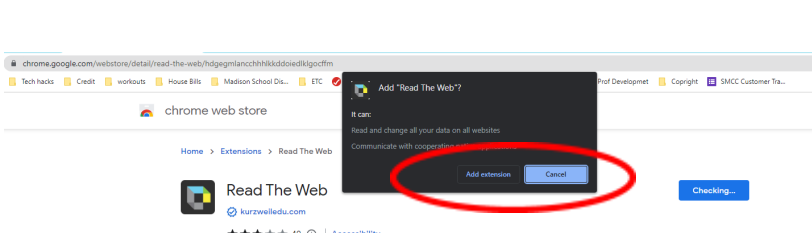
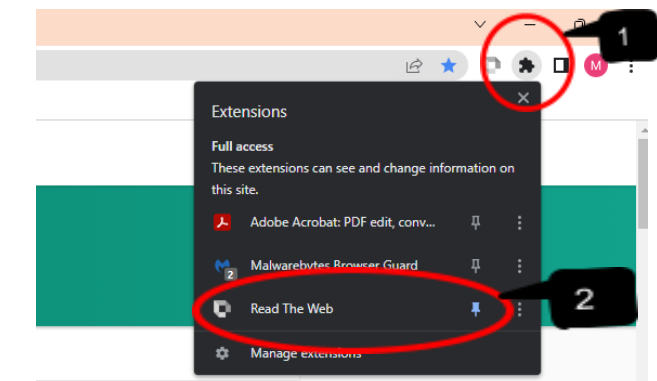
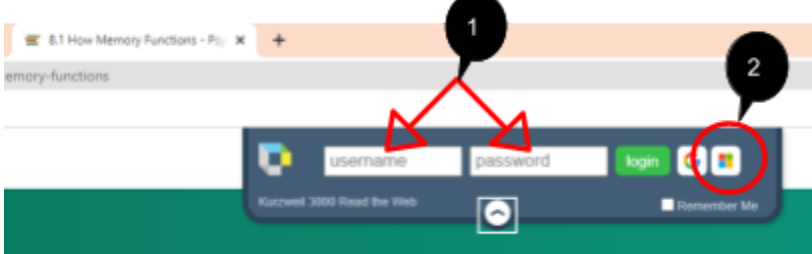




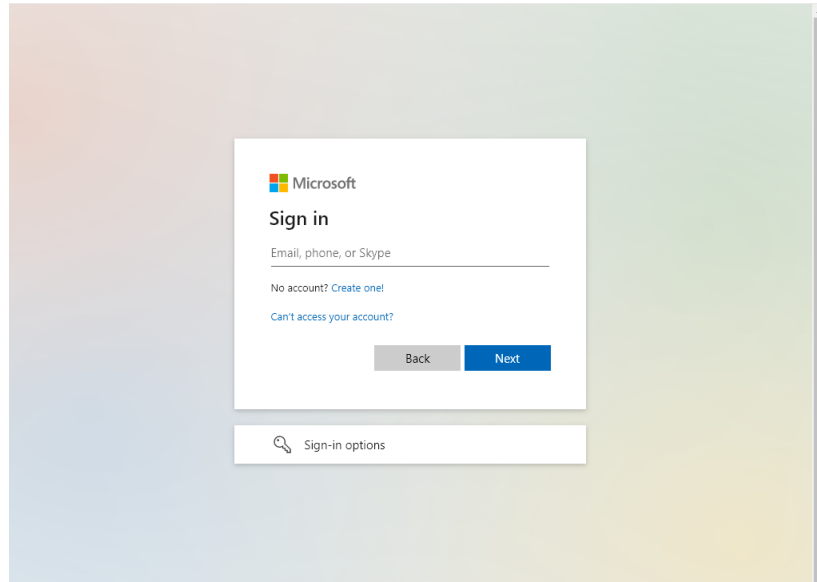
Setting Up Your Kurzweil 3000 Read the Web Extensions

	Step 1 1. Type in Read the Web Google Chrome Extension in the search bar 2. Click on Add to Chrome
	Step 2 1. Click on Add Extension in drop down box
	Step 3 1. Click on the puzzle piece next to the browser bar to open the Extensions menu 2. Click on the pin next to Read the Web to pin the icon in the browser bar
	Step 4 1. Enter your username and password in the Read the Web drop down box. 2. Click on the Microsoft Window button. You will be prompted to go through the Maricopa login chute process. *Do not click on the green Login button; you will get an error message. **Click the Remember Me box for later use ***Use the arrow in the white circle to hide the box.

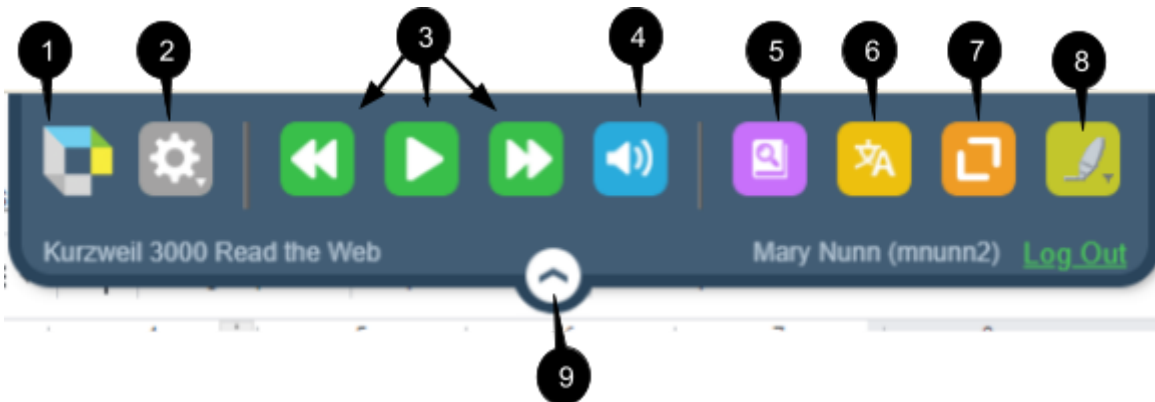


Step 5

1. Sign in with your MEID@maricopa.edu and click next
2. Complete the login chute process with password and Duo Push



The Read the Web Toolbar has 10 buttons:



1. **Kurzweil** Button: select to open Kurzweil 3000.
2. **Options** Button - This allows for the student to control the speed, voice type, unit (how the screen reader highlights what is being read), and mode
3. **Read Navigation** Buttons: Play button to begin screen reader, go back, or skip ahead
4. **Audible/Silent Reading** Toggle: select mute sound; select again to hear sound
5. **Dictionary and Thesaurus**
6. **Translation** button: There are 12 language speech/audio translations, and a great number of non-speech language translation categories
7. **Screenshot Reader** button: take a screenshot of a web page, image, etc for reading in Kurzweil 3000
8. **Highlighter** button: annotate text using various strategies
9. **Show/Hide Display** toggle: click on arrow to minimize or maximize the toolbar
