Classroom Management Plan

In order for our room to be a positive place to learn, it is important that everyone clearly understands my expectations.

#### **Classroom Rules:**

- 1. Show respect for yourself and others at all times.
- 2. Follow directions the first time they are given.

- 4. Come to class with all necessary materials (pencil/pen, paper, journal, novel, etc.)

Discourteous, disruptive, and/or uncooperative behavior will NOT be tolerated. The following consequences will result if any child refuses to abide by the school rules as outlined in the student handbook.

# Make-up work Policy:

In the case of excused absences, students will have the number of days absent to make up missed work for full credit. However, the <u>student is ALWAYS responsible</u> to ask for make-up work to receive full credit. (Refer to Comal ISD grading guidelines.)

### **Late work Policy:**

Any work NOT turned in when it is due is considered LATE. Late work will be given reduced credit. 1 day late = 20% off, 2 days late = 40% off. Work that has not been turned in after 3 days will receive a 0. \*It does NOT mean that you automatically receive an 80 or a 60 for work turned in late.

Work will still be graded.\*

## **Tardy Policy**:

Students are tardy if they are not in their seats and <u>prepared for class</u> when it is time for class to begin. That means you'll have your novel out and <u>begin reading it on your own</u> since you know that's the first thing you'll do in my class each and every day, OR you'll have out your Reader-Writer

(composition) notebook to begin journaling. ALWAYS read the agenda on the board.

So, if you throw down your backpack to run into the hall to chat, to get a drink, whatever, and the bell rings while you're still outside the classroom, YOU are LATE!!!! Your backpack, on the other hand, is NOT late/tardy.  $\odot$
