URL Instructions:

- all sources are valid sources which could **possibly** be used in your paper
- 3 sentence explanation/justification required for a valid .com or .net
 - valid .com sources are generally in the form of newspaper and magazine articles
- .edu, .org, and .gov are preferred and do not require justification
- sources should have an author and publication date (even if it is just a copyright date)
- “wiki how” websites and personal blogs are not considered valid
