Equipment:

Each team furnishes their own equipment except for blocks.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded for Girls and Boys for individual events and relays. The boys and girls team winner will receive a trophy/plaques.

General Information:

Our track requires only 1/4" spikes.

The long jump runway is an all weather surface.

The high jump runway is an all weather surface.

The high jump will start at 4'6" for boys and 4'2" for girls

Concession stand will be open.

Teams may enter:

Three people per field event. Three final attempts. The girls will compete in shot put first and the boys will compete in discus first. The boys will long jump first and the girls will high jump first. All field event participants must check in at the event site upon arrival. SEP will have more than 2 participants in some field events so our kids have a chance to compete.

We will follow the mandatory order of running events for junior high/middle school track and field meets.
