2. Originality

Submitted manuscripts must:

- be original;
- not have been published previously;
- not be under consideration elsewhere;
- be free from plagiarism.

Similarity Index should not exceed **20%**.

3. Manuscript Language

Authors may submit manuscripts in:

- English (preferred)
- Bahasa Indonesia

The title, abstract, and keywords must be provided in English.

4. Paper Length

Full paper:

6–10 pages

including:

- figures
- tables
- references

5. Paper Format

Authors must use the official conference template.

Paper size:

A4

Margins:

- Top : 2.5 cm
- Bottom : 2.5 cm
- Left : 2.5 cm
- Right : 2.5 cm

Font:

Times New Roman

Font size:

11 pt

Single spacing.

6. Paper Structure

The manuscript should consist of:

1. Title
2. Author(s)
3. Affiliation
4. Email
5. Abstract (150–250 words)
6. Keywords (3–5 keywords)
7. Introduction
8. Literature Review
9. Methodology
10. Results and Discussion
11. Conclusion
12. Acknowledgements (optional)
13. References

7. Title

Maximum:

20 words

Use concise and informative wording.

8. Abstract

The abstract should contain:

- background
- objective
- methodology
- findings
- contribution

Length:

150–250 words.

9. Keywords

Provide:

3–5 keywords

Example:

Artificial Intelligence; Computational Thinking; Informatics Education

10. Figures

Figures should:

- be high resolution
- be numbered consecutively
- include captions below the figures
- be cited in the text

Example:

Figure 1. Research Framework

11. Tables

Tables should:

- be editable
- include captions above the tables
- be cited in the text

12. References

Use:

APA 7th Edition

Authors are encouraged to cite recent literature published within the last five years.

Minimum:

20 references

Recommended composition:

- 80% journal articles
- 20% books or conference proceedings

Use reference managers such as:

- Mendeley
- Zotero
- EndNote

13. Ethical Statement

Authors must ensure:

- no plagiarism
- no fabricated data
- no duplicate publication
- proper citation of all sources

14. Review Process

All manuscripts undergo:

Double-Blind Peer Review

Each paper will be reviewed by at least **two reviewers**.

Possible decisions:

- Accept
- Minor Revision
- Major Revision
- Reject

15. Submission

Authors should submit:

- Full paper (.docx)
- Copyright Form
- Statement of Originality

through the conference submission system.
