

Scarsdale Union Free School District - American Rescue Plan Act Funding Plan

In March 2021, the President signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). This act makes available a third round of elementary and secondary emergency relief funds. This funding was provided in part to address learning loss by planning summer learning, enrichment and/or after-school programs. School district plans should be designed to address the social/emotional needs of students as well as academic needs. As of June, 2021, it is anticipated that the Scarsdale Union Free School District will receive an allocation as follows:

- Federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSA Act II) - \$205,893
- American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) - \$462,740

The table below provides a summary plan of the district's intent in allocating the funds to support our students' academic and social/emotional growth. As this allocation covers **multiple years**, it is likely that the intended plan will need to be modified to best meet the changing needs of students. Most of our planned programs/services address non-recurring expenses, and, in accordance with guidance, any programs/services that extend beyond the years covered by the grant allocation will be absorbed by the district's general fund budget through offsets in other areas in a phased in approach over the next three years to ensure no disruptions of services to students.
