Employer Recruitment Timelines

Employer Timelines: Developed by Brandeis University.

- Recruitment timelines vary by industry. If you scroll down the webpage you'll find more information on a particular industry.
- The timelines posted for each industry are intended to serve as general guidelines. Not every employer within an industry will follow these particular timelines.

Internship Websites (Recommended)

<u>Handshake</u> - Access hundreds of internships on Stanford's online opportunity portal There are multiple ways to search for opportunities

From the **Jobs** page

- 1. Click on **ALL Filters** on the top menu
 - Under Job Type, select Internship, Experiential Learning and Fellowships
 - Scroll down the pop up box
 - Under Qualifications, select School Year and/or Graduation Date
 - In the keyword box enter your field or role of interest
- 2. Select **Internship** and choose a **Location** (if you have a preference) on top menu.

Sophomores

In the keyword box:

<u>Strategy 1</u>: Enter Sophomore or Rising Junior

• <u>Strategy 2</u>: Enter school year + industry / role / skill (i.e. sophomore finance, sophomore software engineer or sophomore writing)

First Years

In the keyword box:

- <u>Strategy 1</u>: Enter Freshmen or Freshman
- Strategy 2: Enter school year + industry / role / skill (i.e. freshman + film)

Stanford On- and Off-Campus Learning Opportunities (SOLO):

Listing of internships, fellowships, research, public service, study abroad and more. Use the index on the side to search for 1st and 2nd year opportunities.

Google Internship/Job Search

In the keyword search, enter the role and the term intern (*i.e product intern*) or the industry and the term intern (*marketing intern*) and location.

Indeed.com

In the keyword search, enter a specific role or industry and intern (i.e. *finance intern*) and the location. In some cases adding the year (i.e. sophomore) can help.

Interstride: Internships in U.S. and abroad

Log in with Stanford email. Select *Jobs* and then *Job Search*. In keyword search, enter *intern sophomore* or intern and industry or role.

Idealist.org - Nonprofit internships and jobs

In the first search box select internships. In the keyword box or in the search menu to the left, select an issue area (i.e. climate change or immigrants)

Built In - Startups throughout the U.S.

In the search menu under *Job Category*, select *Internshi*p and choose the location. If you are targeting a particular area of the U.S., click <u>here</u> to see a list of Tech Hubs (i.e <u>Built In SF</u>).
