They fly veterans to Washington DC (out of Appleton Airport) to visit their memorials. If you served in any branch of the military before May 7, 1975 you qualify for a flight.

If interested they need your dates of service and two emergency contacts (names, phone numbers & email). If you would like a specific Guardian they also need their full name, address, phone number, T-shirt size and if a veteran, their service dates. Guardian fee is \$500 and they must be under 70 years old. Current wait for a flight is over a year but priority is given to older vets or those in failing health. You may also sign up just to be a Guardian.
