State Testing

Each year, students across Vermont take state tests in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, and Science. At Grand Isle Supervisory Union, students in grades 3-8 participate. These assessments are called the Vermont Comprehensive Assessment Program (VTCAP). This is the third year we have been using this test in the state. The tests are taken on computers and have many options to support student needs. The tests will be given between March 10 and May 2, 2025. Tests will be given at any time during the testing window and will be held at school during the regular school day. Our school's schedule is below:

Please make sure your student has a good night's sleep and eats a nutritious breakfast before testing. We also encourage students to bring wired headphones from home if they have a pair that is most comfortable for them. We will send home your child's student report once we receive it. State assessments are just one way that we measure student learning. It is important to remember that the VTCAP measures broad areas of understanding while our local assessments are more specific to what students are learning in the moment.
