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| Bench with storage (x4) | \$1000 | The bench will give teachers and students a place to gather while the class is taking a bathroom break. With the below storage, teachers can keep dry erase markers, boards and other manipulatives to inhibit fluency practice. This could also hold books or other independent type games that student can do in the hallway while waiting for their classmates to use the |

| Magnetic/Dry Erase Paint for Walls | \$500 | By making the walls behind the benches dry erase and magnetic with the paint, teachers can use it to instruct and model for each activity. Additionally, these quiet hallway spaces could double as a space for a Teacher Associate to take a small group in order to instruct and work with students. |
| Sensory path from https://thesensorypath.com/ | \$6000 | These sensory paths offer movement breaks for students for all purposes. As it currently stands, the hallways are sterile and slightly dull. Teachers who would share each hallway could choose from many of the sensory options designed by this company. They would have a budget of \$1250 to design their pathway. |
| Bulletin Board Stips - | \$1500 | Installing bulletin board strips will allow for teachers and students to display model work and celebrate their learning! Currently many teachers use sticky tack or teacher tape and need more bulletin board strips. The location would be throughout the entire hallway and perhaps in the classrooms too if needed. |
| Posters/decor | \$500 | Students and teachers need inspiration. Decorations for the hallway might include contact paper type sayings and words, posters, or career or college examples. |

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| Hallway tools/resources | \$500 | This is open for any items teachers feel they may need, but cannot use from their classroom for the hallway. Such items might be: magnetic letters, dry erase markers or boards, books, manipulatives, and paper. |
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
