Federal program providing free meals for all students ending

- Due to the pandemic, the federal government has been providing universal free school meals for students. This program has allowed Upper Arlington Schools and other school districts to provide free lunches to all students since the spring of 2020.
- This federal waiver program expired on June 30, 2022. This means that for the coming school year, free or reduced-price meals will be available <u>only</u> to the families that qualify based upon financial need. All other students will be charged for meals and snacks purchased through the school cafeteria.
