**CONSTITUTION OF THE BARANGAY TASK FORCE AGAINST ROAD OBSTRUCTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16. General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

**WHEREAS**, Section 17. Basic Services and Facilities - Local Government Units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein. (b) Such basic services and facilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (v) Maintenance of Barangay roads and bridges and water supply systems

**WHEREAS**, Section 392 of the Local Government Code provides for Other Duties of Sangguniang Barangay Members (SBMs). In addition to their duties as members of the Sangguniang Barangay, SBMs may:

- (a) Assist the Punong Barangay in the discharge of his duties and functions;
- (b) Act as peace and order officers in the maintenance of public order and safety;
- (c) Perform such other duties and functions as the Punong Barangay may designate.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued DILG MC No. 2024-053, which outlines the guidelines for the nationwide implementation of Barangay Road Clearing Operations, Assessment, Validation, and Recognition under the Bagong Pilipinas Campaign.

**WHEREAS**, under section 5.3.1.2 of DILG-MC 2024-053, all Sangguniang Barangay Members and other elected functionaries are directed to actively join their respective Punong Barangays during the conduct of Barangay Road Clearing Operations (BaRCO).

**WHEREAS**, the City of Manila under the leadership of Honorable Mayor Honey Lacuna-Pangan issued Executive Order Nos. 7 and 7a creating the Manila Task Force Against Road Obstructions.

**NOW, THEREFORE I**, \_\_\_\_\_ Punong Barangay of Barangay \_\_\_\_\_ by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

**Section I.** The Barangay Task Force Against Road Obstruction is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

- CHAIRPERSON : Punong Barangay
- VICE-CHAIRPERSON : Sangguniang Barangay Member  
in charge on Peace and Order
- MEMBERS : SK Chairperson

All Sangguniang Barangay Members  
Chief Tanod (Executive Officer)

SECRETARIAT : Barangay Secretary

**Section II.** The Barangay Task Force Against Road Obstructions shall have the following general duties:

1. Initiate the conduct of inventory and establishment of a database in the barangay which shall contain the following data: barangay roads and its length, identified obstructions and obstruction type;
2. Formulate and implement Barangay Road Clearing Action Plan;
3. Implement BaRCO related ordinances;
4. Spearhead the implementation of the Barangay Road Clearing Operations (BaRCO) in their respective jurisdiction;
5. Coordinate or collaborate with the city, national government agencies concerned, and other stakeholders relative to the implementation road clearing, and monitoring and maintenance of cleared roads;
6. Immediately report or refer to appropriate authorities any violation or concern related to road clearing operations outside the coverage or management of the barangay;
7. Ensure the submission of their respective monthly Barangay Road Clearing Report; and,
8. Perform other tasks as may be directed by the Punong Barangay.

**Section III. Effectivity.** This order shall take effect immediately and all past issuances inconsistent with this order is hereby repealed.
