## SYC Video Guide Checklist

Thank you for volunteering your time to capture the experience of a lifetime for your hunter. First, ensure you you have a camera which can take photo/video and it is sufficiently charged.

There are 5 key opportunities we are especially interested in
1 Blind Photo
Take a photo of your team in front of your blind. Have driver take it so you can be in it.
The best time for this is typically at the conclusion of the first morning hunt when the
driver picks you up
2 Action Photo
Take a photo of the hunter with camo on while hunting in the blind.
3 Kill Photo
If you are taking a shot, make sure you get it on video including panning back to see the
hunter's expressions afterwards.
4 Trophy Photo
If your harvest is successful, take a photo/video of the hunter and team with the animal.
5 Family Photo
Take a photo of the hunter with his/her parent or caregiver.
You are welcome to take as many other photos as you want. We will share all photos with each
