

Rental Vehicles

A rental car is a great option if you want to explore Cleveland and the surrounding areas at your own pace. See specific rental car information below for each airport.

Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE)

CLE has a **Rental Car Center** located across from the main terminal, accessible by a free shuttle bus. The bus ride from the terminal to the rental car facility takes approximately 5-7 minutes and runs continuously 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

- The rental car shuttle departs from the rental car shuttle terminal, located at the Ground Transportation Center (GTC). The GTC is located at the northend of the terminal on baggage level. Travelers can utilize the 2 banks of elevators across from the welcome center or escalators by claim 9 and claim 3 to access the baggage claim level.
- For travelers needing assistance, a telephone center with rental car information is located at the info counter at Baggage Claim.

Rideshare Services

Rideshare services like **Uber** and **Lyft** are available at both airports, with designated pickup and drop-off areas located outside the terminal. However, we do recommend a rental car coming from Akron-Canton Airport due to the drive distance.

You can easily request a ride upon arrival, and drivers will meet you at the designated area. Taxis are also readily available, and the airport has a taxi line just outside the baggage claim area for quick access.
