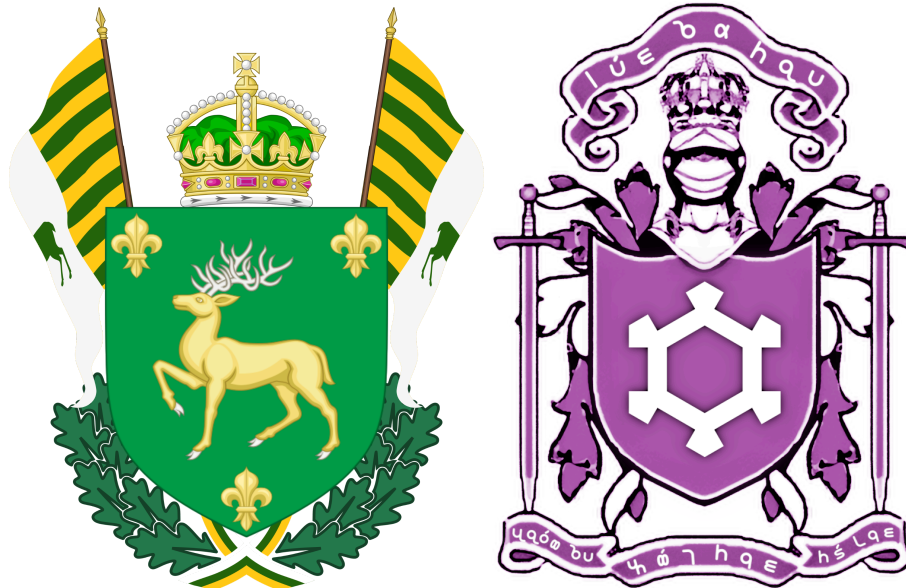




Treaty

of Cooperation between

the Grand Duchy of Misberia and

the Technocratic Republic of Aethodia

In Whitetail, Misberia and Online

On this ninth day of June in the Common Era, 2026

**TREATY OF COOPERATION BETWEEN
THE GRAND DUCHY OF MISBERIA AND
THE TECHNOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF AETHODIA**

The Grand Duchy of Misberia (“Misberia”) and the Technocratic Republic of Aethodia (“Aethodia”), hereafter referred to as “the Parties”,

CONSIDERING the seeds of friendship that exist between the Parties;

DESIRING to facilitate bilateral cooperation between them;

RECOGNIZING that formal relations are foundational to such cooperation;

BEARING IN MIND the respective commitments of the Parties under any pre-existing or future bilateral agreements;

HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Article I: Scope

- A. This Treaty seeks to lay the groundwork for relations, present and future, between the Parties.
- B. This Treaty shall not affect the rights and obligations of the Parties under any other international agreement.

Article II: General Obligations

- A. The Parties recognize each other as independent, sovereign states with legitimate claim to their own respective territories.
- B. The Parties recognize the legitimacy of each other’s governments, citizenships, titles of nobility, orders of precedence, and forms of address; and agree to respect these much as they would their own.
- C. The Parties agree to a Pact of Non-Aggression between them. This prohibits both overt and covert acts of significant hostility between the Parties, including but not limited to military invasion, sabotage, the incitement of unrest, and threats of force.
- D. The Parties pledge goodwill toward each other and reserve the right to call upon each other in times of need, though without there being any implication of obligation for the besought Party to accept.

Article III: Designating Authorities

- A. Each Party shall appoint at least one ambassador to the other.
- B. The Parties may freely choose the ambassador(s) who represents them for the purposes of this article.
- C. Either Party may reject any ambassador chosen by the other Party for the purposes of this Treaty, thus forcing the selection of an alternative.
- D. Parties are not in violation of this article if they are physically unable to staff an ambassador that the other Party will accept.
- E. The Parties will establish a persistent line of reasonably private communication in order to maintain contact and foster future cooperation.

Article IV: Entry into Force, Amendments, Withdrawal

- A. This Treaty shall enter into force at the moment it has been signed by both Parties.
- B. Any Party may propose amendments to this Treaty. Amendments do not become official unless signed by both Parties.
- C. Either Party may terminate this Treaty in part or in whole by first giving the other Party two weeks' notice in writing through a contact channel reasonably believed to be monitored by the other. This notice need not be given if there is no possible way to contact the other Party, or if the other Party is actively in violation of the part being terminated.
- D. All obligations are symmetrical. Anything terminated for one Party is automatically terminated for the other. Any part violated by one Party is temporarily non-binding for the other for the duration of that violation.
