Psalm 91 Community Group Questions

Pray for the community groups and new community group opportunities.

- 1. Ice breaker: Can you think of a situation when you were miraculously delivered or protected "against all odds"?
- 2. Verses 1&2: what four names of God does the psalmist use? What does it mean to dwell in the shelter of the Most High?
- 4. Verses 3 8: What types of disasters are discussed? What kinds of dangers are common in our lives?
- 5. Verses 9 & 10: Is God's protection available to everyone? What does it mean to make God your dwelling place? Does God's protection mean Christians are immune from any and all harm?
- 6. If you are living by faith, are you living dangerously? Does God want us to play it safe?
- 7. Verses 11 & 12: Where in the New Testament are these verses quoted and by whom? (hint: Luke 4) Since our enemy misinterpreted and misapplied this scripture to our Lord, can we expect him to attempt to distort its message in our lives?
- 8. What do you think angels look like, and what do they spend their time doing? Read Hebrews 1:14; 13:1-2.
- 9. Verses 14 16: What two things for deliverance are stated in verse 14?
- 10. Describe the refuge God promises to provide?
- 11. Verse 15 talks about calling upon the Lord. Where else in the bible does it talk about this? Read Mat 7:7-8. Prink about: What are you particularly anxious about these days for which God is waiting on you to call His name and acknowledge your need?
- 11. In what ways can we be a refuge to others as a church and individually?

Read Psalm 98 to prepare for Sunday.
