	Today we will learn signs for Farm Animals.	
	 (start of the lesson) Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria. Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary. 	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch lesson 7 video.	Lesson 7 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time. Signs taught: Farm, Animal, Cow, Sheep, Lamb, Duck, Bull, Pig, Horse, Dog, Cat, Donkey, Mouse, Goat, Rooster, Chicken, Rabbit, Goose, Frog, Fish, Farmer, Tractor.	Farm animals
5 mins	Explanation of the Activity:	
J	 Teacher and students to get into small groups. Take it in turns - one person must act out the Farm Animal (like mime - no voice or animal noises!) The other students must guess what the Farm Animal isbut only by Signing it - no voice answers. Students can also sign yes and no to confirm if they are correct. (this game can also be played in a circle with the whole class) 	

	 Second Activity: Play - Reach the Farmer One student or teacher (the farmer) stands at the front of the room. All the other students stand at the back The farmer signs an animal. If the students know the animal they can put up their hand (the farmer - or the real teacher) can pick student. That student can voice the answer. If they are correct - they can take one step towards the farmer - but it must be a step of that animal. (eg. rabbit - one hop forward. Duck - one waddle forward) First to reach the Farmer wins. EXTRA ACTIVITY Practise song 'Old Mac Donald had a Farm' For 'Old Mac Donald '- the students can sign OldMD. (they can check Alphabet Sign Sheet for letters M & D) 	
15 mins	 Activity: Guess the Farm Animal Reach the Farmer Practise Song - Old Mac Donald 	Sign Reference Sheet
5 mins	Reflection with students: (Select from the following) What was hard (challenging) today? What was fun for you today? What are your favourite Farm Animal Signs? What is your favourite animal?
