Introduction:

- Many new Town of La Grange, WI residents are putting yard waste in paper bags, and expecting that it will get picked up with their regular trash and recycling.
- In response to many residents not knowing about or understanding how to compost such things as grass clippings, leaves, brush, and tree limbs, the Town of La Grange is going to post an instructional video on their website.

Learning Objectives:

Upon completion of this training, the learner will be able to:

- Identify the yard waste that can be taken to the compost site.
- Describe the location and hours of the compost site.

Outline:

• New residents are frustrated because their yard waste is not getting picked up with their regular trash and recycling. A neighbor of one of the new residents explains that there is a compost site, where yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, brush, and tree limbs) can be taken.

	Cheri: Hi Don! You look frustrated. What's wrong? Don: Well, I mowed my entire yard, put all of the grass clippings in yard waste bags, but the garbage trucks didn't pick them up. What are we supposed to do with all of our yard waste?	Cheri comes for the left and moves right toward the trash and yard bags. Dissolve transition to the next slide.	

Cheri: Ahh! I can see why you'd be frustrated. Johns Disposal Service only picks up refuse and recycling, so the Town of LaGrange has a compost site.	
Don: Compost site? I have never heard of something like that. Where is it and what can I take there?	
Cheri: The compost site is located about 10 to 15 minutes north west of us.
