Quotations and Bibliography

The journal follows a direct quotation style. Short quotes (four lines or fewer) should be integrated into the main text, while longer quotes (more than four lines) must be indented with 1.5 pt spacing and enclosed in quotation marks. Citations should include the author's surname either before or after the quote, formatted in parentheses as follows:

- Single author: (Smith, 2005: 42)
- Three or more authors: (Johnson et al., 2010: 15)
- Multiple pages: (Smith, 2005: 42-45)
- Entire text reference: (Smith, 2005)
- Online sources: (BBC News, 2022, para. 4)

For direct quote that is less than 4 lines it is integrated in the text, example:

- According to Archer (2001, p. 73), “these apparent deviations from the rule of unanimity do not undermine a member’s ability to use an international organization as an instrument of policy.”

Direct quote that is longer than 4 lines must be separated from the text in a block quote, example:

- “A second image of the role of international organizations is that of their being arenas or forums within which actions take place. In this case, the organizations provide meeting places for members to come together to discuss, argue, co-operate or disagree. Arenas in themselves are neutral; they can be used for a play, a circus or a fight” (Archer, 2001, p. 73).

Footnote

A footnote is use for supplemental notes of explaining certain concepts or definition.
