Say Something Anonymous Reporting Tool Information

In response to this week being Arkansas Safe Schools Week and Valley View's commitment to safety and security, we are releasing the Say Something Reporting Tool. This is an anonymous reporting form that will alert school officials of safety concerns such as bullying/cyber-bullying, violence/threats, potential fights, drugs/alcohol, weapons, etc. Safety concerns may be reported at anytime, but the reports are only monitored

during school hours. If you need to report an emergency, please call 911 or if appropriate, call 988 to reach the National Suicide & Crisis Lifeline.

School personnel will investigate each situation reported and respond accordingly. Our district takes every report seriously and hopes this tool ensures continued safety for all students and staff.

Based on A.C.A. 6-13-631 and the Valley View School District having greater than 10% minority population according to the 2020 Census, the Valley View School Board will be composed of seven (7) board members following the general election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The seven board positions consist of five (5) single-member zones elected by the registered voters in each respective zone and two (2) at-large positions elected by all registered voters in the district. In the November election, the board members for each of the five single-member zones will be elected. Current board members drew lots for the two at-large positions, and Lee Lane and Richard Rogers drew for these positions, which will not be on the ballot in November. The

Due to safety concerns, the district wants to notify all drivers that driving around vehicles in the drop-off and pick-up lines is not allowed unless you are directed to do so by a police officer or school administrator. Effective immediately citations could be issued by JPD if you pass other vehicles.

If you need to get to the elementary or intermediate afternoon staging areas, our district encourages you to decrease your wait time by using an alternate path to keep you from having to wait on Valley View Drive since passing is not allowed.
