- Main idea 1: no matter how important these subjects are, rendering them compulsory may adversely impact students in many ways. - Supporting idea: This amount of time could have been otherwise allotted for other classes that they are more interested in [so that](#) they could make full use of their time for what they like.

- Main idea 2: should art be obligatory at school, students who are not artistically gifted may have great difficulty achieving good grades at this subject. - Supporting idea: It is not easy for everyone to improve their artistic skills for a short [period](#) of time, which may negatively affect the students' GPA at the end of the term.
