**Training of Technical Assistance Providers on Specific Areas of SEPM**

OVERVIEW OF THE TRAINING

- **What is the Responsible Inclusive Finance Facility?:** The Responsible Inclusive Finance Facility (RIFF) is a project managed by Cerise+SPTF and funded by the Swiss Agency for Cooperation and Development (SDC), and the Government of Luxembourg via a fund administered by the European Investment Bank (EIB). The purpose of the RIFF is to strengthen the Social and Environmental Performance Management (SEPM) practices, including client protection practices, of financial institutions in Sub-Saharan Africa.
- **Training Curriculum:** This training for TA providers is designed to explore in depth one specific area of SEPM, with the goal of building expertise that they can apply to their work helping financial institutions to improve their SEPM practices. The course is not introductory but intended to build on participants' previous experience with SEPM. The training curriculum will integrate lecture, interactive group exercises, and discussion.
- **Duration:** 1-2 days
- **Eligibility:** All TA providers who have some knowledge of SEPM and experience working in the inclusive finance sector are welcome to apply.
- **Language of instruction:** This training may be offered in English or French. This application form will ask you for your preferred language.
- **Cost:** Registration for this training is free. Additionally, the training will provide lunch at no cost each day to participants. However, all applicants are responsible for their own transportation to and from the training site, and for their own lodging. Participants will not receive a per diem allowance or be remunerated for their time.
- **Required materials:** All participants must bring a laptop to this training.
- **Date of the training:** The RIFF is not able to schedule the trainings in advance of reviewing the applications. The form below asks for your preferred timing for the training, and the RIFF will do its best to accommodate your request.
- **Location of the training:** To be determined. The RIFF decides where to hold trainings in response to applicant demand.
- **Deadline to submit application:** None. RIFF accepts applications on a rolling basis.
