- 1) Welcome
- 2) Introductions
- 3) Review and approved March 2022 meeting minutes: motion to approve made by Megan Devlin and seconded by Todd Varnell; motion approved unanimously
- 4) Treasurer's report:
  - a. Highlights: Net income decreased about \$3,000 to overall NI of \$13,311 compared to target of <\$18,204.75>. This will leave us money to spend in the year. Would like to keep some money in the account for the beginning of next year so we have about \$25,000 to spend.
  - b. Snack shack, merchandise sales and a donation are income sources
  - c. Expenses came from non-sports and sports items, snack shack supplies and some merchandise purchases.
  - d. Motion to pay for past golf course fees for approx. \$1,100; made by Angie Lu and seconded Todd Varnell; Passed with 1 abstention.
  - e. Re: 501c3 status. IRS is asking for tax returns and Maureen wrote a letter to say have filed via HSC. She is sorting out getting the right designation of 501c3 versus current 501c4. Maureen is working on it since tax season makes finding a professional resource very difficult.
- 5) AD Update
  - a. Boys Vball back into league play working on qualifying for CCS; softball played an exhibition game to support Relay for Life; track and field will have some individuals will qualify with maybe a relay team. Leigh is hosting track and field championships as well as badminton. Tennis and Golf will have individual CCS qualifiers. Badminton is undefeated and Baseball also undefeated.
  - b. College signing day will be Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, at lunch in the quad.
- 6) Coach or Sports Rep Update
  - a. Swim presented by Coach Kyle - kids are swimming well. Varsity boys 3/1, Varsity girls 2/2, JV boys 3/1, JV girls 2/2. All relays have CCS qualified. Took 16 athletes to Clovis meet last weekend. Varsity is getting ready for BVALs
- 7) Committee Reports
  - a. Donation Drive/Fundraising: Just keeping going with donations as normal; Idea for next year's fundraising via Angie of a Karoke/CornHole Tournament with coaches and parents. Looking at 9/24 at Belwood Cabana and food trucks
  - b. Merchandise: Sales continuing of various items and also remind middle schools to buy for their graduates.

- c. Communications: Working on more “Meet the Coaches”
  - d. Senior Recognition: 4 sports left to be done. Delivered at graduation practice like last year.
  - e. Snack Shack: Still looking for someone to take over the job. May need to be made more sport specific and ask for coach’s support to look for each season.

  - b. Sports booster board recruiting: several of the positions have people that need to be voted upon in roles.
