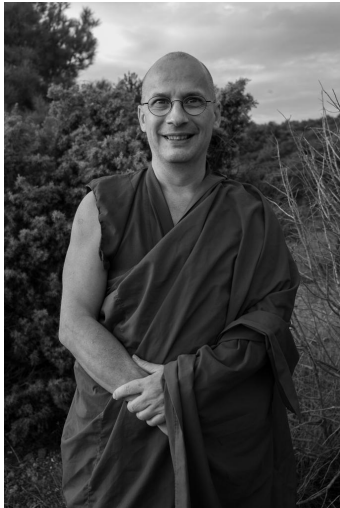




Tenzin Peljor (Michael Jäckel) is a German Buddhist monk and former member of two Buddhist cults within Tibetan Buddhism in non-heritage Buddhist countries. He started a website on Buddhist cults, www.buddhistische-sekten.de, in 2004. Other websites he set up, www.info-buddhism.com and www.info-buddhismus.de, aim to address complex issues related to Tibet, Tibetan Buddhism, the Dalai Lamas as well as Buddhism in general.
