

Democratic Party of Sacramento County
General Membership Meeting Minutes

8/11/2022 – DPSC Zoom

The meeting was called to order at about 6PM, the roll was taken as recorded in the roll call document.

A motion was made by J.D. Garcia and seconded to add to the agenda a vote for a resolution for state scientists' pay equity. The motion carried.

The agenda as amended was adopted by unanimous consent

The prior minutes were adopted by unanimous consent

Several elected officials or their staffers who were present spoke briefly

The Controller's report was not available and a motion carried to email it out and to pick up the regular reporting next month.

A. Tellechea made the fundraising committee report.

E. Sunderland made the Region 3 Director's report and announced that there would be an endorsement caucus for AD 10.

T. Stafford called for nominations for filling the vacancy on the executive board for Controller.

Diana Rodriguez was nominated by Mario Guerrero and Therese Riviera and was the sole nominee.

D. Rodriguez was elected by unanimous consent to the Executive Board position of Controller.

M. Guerrero made a motion to charter the following list of seven clubs and to extend for one more month the time period for the rest of the clubs to meet the chartering requirements. The motion was seconded. The motion carried by a vote of 36 yes to zero no.

M. Guerrero stated that he wished to abstain from the vote on the resolution due to his job duties in his employment.

The resolution Supporting the California Association of Professional Scientists was adopted by unanimous consent.

J. Cameron presented the bylaws changes up for a vote in the next general meeting. Those are:
Item 2022-1, a bylaws change placing time limits on debate for business items.
Item 2022-2, a standing rule change regarding debate times and number of debaters for main motions and subsidiary and incidental motions. Also includes a bylaws removal since it moves some of this from the bylaws to a standing rule.

There was a question regarding members who have had enough unexcused absences in the general meetings to lose their membership under the rules with some question and answer.

Various club reports and announcements were made.
