- **How to approach this knowledge transfer**

- **What, where, when, why, who:** to gather the context
- **Past, present and future:** to gather overarching vision
- **Offboarding within the infra team:** who's the replacement? What are things they currently don't know that only Rosa knows? What tasks usually piled up when Rosa was on vacation/leave?
- **Screencast** Rosa's debugging process for real issue (if it happens) or mock issue
