



Concurrent Enrollment

Poudre School District Front Range & Aims Community Colleges - Campus Select Eligibility

1. If the class is offered as at the student's high school or the PSD Career Tech Center (CTC) for college credit (including CU Succeed), students will not be approved to take the class online or at the FRCC or Aims campus.
2. The number of campus select credits allowed each year is limited. No campus select will be allowed until spring semester sophomore year.
 - *Certificate Programs not offered at the CTC are an exception (for example: Welding)
 - 0 credits Freshman year
 - 3 credits Sophomore year (spring semester only)
 - 9 credits Junior year
 - 12 credits Senior year
3. College course(s) selected by the student must be approved by PSD in advance through the [PSD Campus Select Student Application](#) by the determined deadline.
4. Must be enrolled in one class on the high school campus where daily attendance is recorded during Q1, and must have full-time student status between college and high school in the fall.
5. High school students who are retained for instructional purposes beyond their 4th year in high school may not enroll in more than 9 college credits (maximum of 6 in any semester) for the remainder of their time in high school. Classes must meet graduation requirements if taken in the fall (there are no exceptions as this is legislated).
6. If a student fails a course or withdraws from more than one course, they must sit out a semester before taking additional courses at the college campus. Students may be able to retake a course they previously failed if it lines up with their ICAP and they need it to proceed with their certification or Associate degree pathway. Students cannot retake an elective course. If a student is on Academic Probation with FRCC or Aims, they are not eligible.
7. Students are required to apply for the campus select course(s) they want to take each semester through the application in Step 3. Upon approval, they must complete the concurrent enrollment agreement form they are sent through [PSD Forms](#).
