Eventually there is a five district director committee to decide on the self reporting violations.

Coaches Passes - Yes, WIAA is accepting WSCA passes.

We have cut one position at WIAA, to help with the budget deficit. It took one hour for Mick to get from the entrance gate to get to the floor at the state basketball tournament.

We have been working with Go Fan for passes that are not transferable.

A coach would be let into an event if they have cleared the three year coaches' hours requirement and have not been ejected and would be let in for free.

US supreme court is looking into Idaho and West Virginia's transgender laws. California have added an additional place in state meets to transgender athletes.
