

Street trees which are placed behind a sidewalk on closed section roads or at least eight feet from the edge of paving on open section roads usually do not obstruct sight distance and are generally not subject to these restrictions. However, a case by case review may be necessary depending on the species of tree used.

- Only DNR Approved Trees
- Street Trees should not be placed:
  - within 100 Feet of the Face of a STOP or YIELD Sign
  - within 50 Feet of the Face of Any Other Street Sign
  - within 25 Feet of a Street Light
  - within 150 Feet of the Intersection to the Left or Within 100 Feet of the Intersection to the Right Along a Cross Street at an Intersection Controlled by A STOP or YIELD Sign
- Lane Closures Require a Rights of Way Permit
- Rights of Way Permitting Review for any Project Placing 5 Or More Trees in a County Maintained ROW
