# MUST & SHOULD

## Obligation & Recommendation

### MUST

- official, written rule  
You **must** be 18 or older to vote in the U.S.
- duty / strong moral obligation  
You **must** respect your parents.
- very strong recommendation  
You **must** visit DC when you're in the U.S.

### SHOULD

- personal obligation / moral obligation (weaker than "must")  
I **should** save more money each month.  
I **should** call my brother more often.
- recommendation  
She **should** wear a suit to the interview.

### HAVE TO

*NOT a modal verb*

- changes form  
I **HAVE TO** finish this report by 5:00.  
She **HAS TO** finish this report by 5:00.
- often used in place of **MUST** when speaking
- necessity I **have to** wear glasses to see.
