## TPE 1: Engaging and Supporting All Students in Learning

- Utilizes knowledge of students to engage them in the learning process (at least 50% of the time)
- \* Utilizes active learning experiences to enhance student engagement.
  - Talk less & students talk more
  - Walk around the room checking on students as you teach
  - Students work with partners or in groups
  - Pacing: keep a perky pace
- Connects the subject matter to real-life contexts.
- Provides a supportive learning environment for all students

## TPE 4: Planning Instruction and Designing Learning Experiences for All Students

- Accesses and prepares resources and materials in advance of the lesson.
- Follows a lesson plan effectively to promote learning opportunities.
- Identifies student learning needs prior to a lesson to maximize productivity.

- \* Plan for how you will assess the students' learning during the lesson.
- \* Plan for how you will assess the students' learning at the end of the lesson.

## Be specific:

What are you saying and doing?
What questions will you ask?
How will you activate students' prior knowledge?
What are the students doing and saying?
Plan for small table groups and for whole class time. Maybe plan partner work.
Plan for monitoring students as they work.
