IMSE Orton-Gillingham Plus Scope & Sequence- KINDERGARTEN

The **IMSE OG** program, or Institute for Multi-Sensory Education Orton-Gillingham program, is a structured, multi-sensory method for teaching reading and spelling. It focuses on teaching language concepts systematically and in a way that engages multiple senses (like seeing, hearing, and touching) to reinforce learning.

Red Words are special words that children must memorize by sight because they can't be sounded out the way most words can. They are often taught using multi-sensory strategies to help students remember them. Children need to be able to recognize these words instantly when reading and spell them correctly when writing, even though they don't follow the usual rules. Learning Red Words helps build reading fluency and comprehension.
