Title of the project	Europe: The Puzzle of Diversity
Category	SPORTS, GAMES, TOYS
Title of the activity	Dodgeball
Year/Group	9-12 year-old students
Learning Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To raise awareness on the importance of working as a member of a team 2. To develop personality. 3. To develop movement coordination 4. To get students understand, accept and keep the rules of the game. 5. Motivate students 6. To develop students' reactivity and sense of balance 7. Celebrating a diversity of cultural traditions that promotes tolerance and understanding.
Resources	<p>Video of how Dodgeball is played</p> <p>A rubber ball and 2 benches</p>
Introduction of the lesson	Short introduction of the game and rules
Main Lesson	<p>Introduce students to the rules of the game:</p> <p>The main objective in dodgeball is to eliminate all members of the opposing team by throwing the ball at them.</p> <p>*Players who are thrown by the ball fall out of the game.</p> <p>*Players are allowed to leave the court to collect balls but they are not allowed to throw the ball until they are back within the court.</p>

	<p>*When a player catches a ball, the throwing player will be eliminated.</p> <p>* The game is over when all of the players on one team are eliminated, resulting in the other team winning the game.</p> <p>Ask students if they have understood the rules.</p> <p>Teacher shows students a video of how Dodgeball is played.</p> <p>Teacher makes up 2 teams of the students.</p> <p>Students play the game, the teacher is the referee of the game.</p>
Assessment	To assess students' understanding, teacher has the students play the game.
Reflection	Students are invited to share feelings and discuss ideas how many other ways they know to play dodgeball.
