C. Result and Discussion (Cambria 12 pt, Bold)

1. Body of the Article (finding, analysis or discussion) (Cambria 11 pt, Bold)

This section contains an explanation of the results or research findings. Research findings are analyzed by reference to theoretical foundations. This section's sub-sections of the discussion can be displayed with their bold titles. (Cambria 11 pt).

Placement of Tables and Figures

Tables and figures must be placed Tables and figures must be placed at the middle of the page, center right and left.




Figure 1. Public Statement on Divorce (Cambria, 10 pt)

Bibliography sources are recommended from the last ten years published, preferably from scientific journal articles with a percentage of 40% of all references. The format for writing a bibliography follows the Chicago Manual of Style 17th Edition (complete note) format instructions. Writing should use Mendeley or Zotero reference management applications. (Cambria 11 pt).
