



ICE ALASKA

ACCOMMODATION POLICY

Effective 1st October 2022

PURPOSE - *to ensure that volunteers understand the terms & conditions from Ice Alaska.*

This sections applies to all - Artists, Bootcampers & Volunteers

- Artists, Bootcampers & Volunteers whose registration has been accepted, shall be provided accommodations if they live more than **50 miles** from the Tanana Valley State Fairgrounds. All acceptances must be received in writing by the Admin & Support Staff.
- Two people will be allocated per room and unless pre-arranged, roommates will be paired by Admin staff on registration. Where necessary sculptors from different teams will be paired.
- Ice Alaska is **NOT** responsible for any guests, spouses, children, friends, significant others. Artists must contact the hotel directly to pay and arrange for additional nights, change in rooms, upgrades or any other requirements. Artists will be held financially responsible for any incidents, problems, breakages, venue policy breaches.
- **Our Host Hotel is a 100% drug free zone.** It has a **Zero Tolerance Policy** for the entire property. The usage or storage (even if not using) of marijuana, paraphernalia, vaping pens, and smoking is NOT allowed on the property, in the rooms or room balconies. If you are asked to leave the hotel for any reason, use of drugs or misconduct, Ice Alaska will **NOT** be responsible for any penalties, cleaning fees, or any lodging. Please check with hotel staff for cigarette smoking designated areas.
- Accommodation is at the discretion of Ice Alaska. If you are dismissed as an Artist, Bootcamper or Volunteer by the Ice Alaska Management, for any kind of **misconduct or negligence**, your accommodation will be terminated effective immediately. The Host Hotel will be notified and you will be solely responsible for any extra costs incurred thereafter.

Artists

- Accommodation paid for by Ice Alaska will begin two (2) nights before the start of your competition and finishes the night after the Competition(s) Award Ceremony. Any deviation from the booking becomes the financial responsibility of the Artist.
- Ice Alaska will provide lodging for those out-of-town Artists whose application is **accepted** by Ice Alaska. To be accepted, all registration forms, waivers and payments must be completed.

Bootcampers and Volunteers



- Accommodation paid for by Ice Alaska will begin one (1) night before the start of your assignment and will continue until the last day of your assignment. Any deviation from the booking becomes the financial responsibility of the Bootcamper or Volunteer.
- Ice Alaska will provide lodging for those out-of-town individuals whose application is **accepted** by Ice Alaska. To be accepted, all forms and payments must be completed. All Bootcampers and Volunteers must also be able to meet the working days criteria. Please see policies for Volunteers and Bootcampers on the website.
- To qualify for accommodation, Volunteers must be able to work 6hrs a day for 14 days with every 7th day off. Bootcampers must be able to work 8hrs a day for 14 days with every 7th day off. Education classes will be included in the work hours and at the discretion of the Bootcamp Leader.

Deviations to this policy may only be approved by a majority vote from the Board of Ice Alaska or the Event Co-ordinator in consultation with the Bootcamp Leader. Such approval shall only be in writing and on a case by case basis.

This Accommodation Policy is intended to be fair and equitable to everyone participating and contributing towards the Ice Alaska & World Ice Art Championships event.
