How to Create your Questions

Yes-No Questions:

- These always begin with an Auxiliary Verb. We don't need a question word for Yes-No questions.
- Auxiliary Verbs: Is/Are/Was/Were, Do/Does/Did, Have/Has

Information Questions:

- These always begin with a question word first and then an auxiliary verb.
- Question Words: Who, What, When, Where, Why, How, How Many, How Often, How Much/Many
- Auxiliary Verbs: Is/Are/Was/Were, Do/Does/Did, Have/Has

Yes/No: Aux +Person/Thing + Action
Information: Question Word + Aux +Person/Thing + Action
