



The Pennsylvania Senate could soon vote on House Bill 1808, a bill that could have far-reaching ramifications for single-use plastics and pollution in the Commonwealth.

Specifically, House Bill 1808 would reduce regulatory requirements for so-called “plastics-to-fuel” facilities that take single-use plastics and turn them into fuels that will later be burned.

This bill would create a new statewide definition for “advanced recycling” and would allow these facilities to call themselves recycling facilities, when that couldn’t be further from the truth.

The time is now to reduce our carbon footprint, to reduce our dependence on fossil fuels, and to break our addiction to single-use plastics. House Bill 1808 would do the exact opposite, which is why we need you to contact your state senator NOW and demand a NO vote on House Bill 1808.

Instead of encouraging the use of clean and renewable energy, House Bill 1808 would encourage turning plastics into products like jet fuel and crude oil, all under the guise of “recycling.”

In addition, this bill is likely to result in the burning of plastic waste instead of recycling it, while it will also increase emissions and pollution that exacerbate the ongoing climate crisis.
