Supplemental and Track Specific Rules

Bridge

The lights on either side of the bridge allowing ingress and egress to the paddock are on a timer. The lights will change approximately every 90 seconds, and must be obeyed.

Cameras

All externally mounted cameras must be hard mounted and be tied with a steel tether. No suction cup devices will be allowed. Nothing may be affixed to the driver/rider helmets includingGoPro cameras.

Camping

Free camping is available Friday and Saturday night. Please set up anywhere on the paddock that is out of the way. Power is limited.

Children

Small children must be under supervision by an adult at all times and cannot be on pit lane.

Drones

Except those operated by Northeast GT's media team, unmanned aircraft systems and drones are prohibited.

Electricity

Hook-ups are limited in the paddock and non-existent in the pit lane. Bring generators.

Food

The food shack by the bridge as well as the Raceway Restaurant and Bar will be open though hours may vary.

Fires and Grilling

Fires are allowed only in designated camping areas and must be in containers designed for that purpose. Small home grills, hibachis and small gas grills are permitted in the paddocks, if operated in a safe manner.

Flagtronics

Northeast GT will be operating its Flagtronics electronic flagging and lighting system. In-car units will be available for rent and purchase. Rentals can be added to your team registration. Update to the latest non org specific firmware. Incar USB power must be 2.0 amp or greater. Charge before the event and overnight to ensure proper function.

Fluid Disposal

Fluid wastes must be placed in approved TSMP disposal containers located at various sites in the paddocks and NEVER on the ground.

Fuel

Sunoco Racing Fuels are available at the fuel station behind the garages in Paddock "A". The following fuels will be available: 93 Unleaded, 260 GTX (98 Unleaded), 110 Leaded, 112 Leaded. Fueling is not permitted in the garage area at any time. All fuel cans must be left outside the garage at all times – regardless of whether full or not.

Garages

Garage spaces are 16' wide and approximately 30' deep, and are available (\$75/day) directly from Northeast GT. Send an email to request one. The first 15 teams to register receive a garage for free, but please confirm if your team wants one or not via email.

Grid Location

Cars will be gridded LeMans style on pit road.

Grid Order

All teams will be gridded by class and the order in which they registered.

Merchandise

The Thompson Speedway gift shop is typically open. Northeast GT merchandise will be available for purchase at the information tent.

Media info

For media/press looking to obtain a media pass and capture the event/teams, email Race@Northeast-GT.com, AND check-in with registration for credentials.

<u>Pets</u>

Must remain on leashes and under the direct control of their owners at all times. No pets on pit lane.

Pit Lane

Pit stalls for this event will be first come, first serve. Setup may begin at 9am Friday and equipment may be left overnight. For ease of definition and enforcement, "working on the car" while fueling will be defined as jacking the car, having the hood up or having the trunk open if not required for fueling. Also, crew members not involved in fueling should not be near the fuel port.

Rain or shine

We race in the Northeast, so we drive rain or shine.

Showers

Located in the bathrooms before crossing the bridge into the paddock.

Shipping

Shipments must be clearly marked with the Team/Organization's name. TSMP will not be held responsible for any packages delivered to the property. Shipments may be sent to:

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the hot pits, anywhere that fuel is being dispensed, or in any facility building or garage.

Sound and Quiet Hours

Race/unmuffled engines may not be started prior to 8:00am. The starting of race/unmuffled engines prior to these times is expressly forbidden and violators may be subject to immediate removal. At no time may vehicle noises be in violation of TSMP's 103 dB limit (at 50ft from moving vehicle).

Traffic Flow and Cords

10mph paddock speed limit. The traffic flow in the paddock is counter-clockwise. So when traveling in the garage area, the building should stay to the driver's left. In addition, cords may not run across the travel lane during on-track activity. Cords being run while the track is cold must be covered by a yellow jacket cable protector.

Trailer Parking

Park in the main Paddock "A" as there should be plenty of space without needing to use Paddock "B".

Track Damage

Racers are liable for costs associated with any track damage stemming from incidents such as barrier damage, oil spills, or fuel leaks. The determination of responsibility will be exclusively up to Northeast GT staff and officials.

Transponders

MyLaps or Westhold transponders may be used.

Event Guide

Team Captain Registration & Check-In

Online / before the event:

- All team captains will need to register their team and car on the event MSR page and are responsible for the team's entry fees.
- All GTC cars need a classification form filled out for the database on the NEGT website.

At the track:

- Check-in at registration and provide any missing information from your entry.
- Collect any needed decals, including your full NEGT decal package and your driver or crew wristband.
- Collect rental items such as Flagtronics units and transponders.

Driver and Over-the-Wall Crew Registration & Check-in

For those needing to complete annual gear tech, self gear tech forms should be completed ahead of time online, but can be done at the event.

Online / before the event:

- All drivers and crew need to register online on MotorsportReg.
- Have or complete a current self tech form online.
- All drivers must hold or apply for a NEGT Race or School license.

At the track:

- Check-in at registration and complete any needed paperwork.
- Bring your helmet if you do not already have a gear tech sticker for the current year.
- Collect a helmet sticker if needed and a wristband.

Annual Vehicle Tech Inspection

Online / before the event:

- Complete an online NEGT classing calculator submission.
- Review the rulebook and ensure your car is compliant with the rules. Use a copy of the tech form as a guide and contact NEGT with any questions.
- Gather any previous documentation such as logbooks and tech sheets.
- GTC cars should print out a copy of their classification form and bring it with them.

At the track:

- Bring your car and any documentation to the tech bays (garages #1-4 at TSMP).
- A NEGT representative will do a safety check and, for GTC cars, a review of your online classification form as well as a class inspection including vehicle weight.
- Decal packages, including placement and correct classing, will be verified.
- Tires will be marked with the corresponding color to their category.
- NEGT Annual Tech sticker will be provided by an NEGT official once vehicle tech is complete.
