The Lac La Biche Agricultural Society will award up to two (2) students a tuition - based award in the amount of \$1,000 each for pursuing a career in agriculture or related environmental field.

Award Criteria

- ❑ **Eligibility:**
 - Students enrolled in a program of studies leading to, or achieving a certificate, college diploma, university degree or post- graduate studies in agriculture, the agri-food industry or related environmental field.
 - Your Social Insurance Number and official confirmation of enrolment and attendance by the post-secondary institution are required before any award will be granted.
- ❑ **Copies:** It is recommended that students retain a copy of their application.

NB: The first half of the scholarship (\$500) will be paid to the successful recipients. The remaining half of the scholarship will be paid to the applicant upon successful completion of the first semester of the application year. A transcript is required.
