			<p>available. Principal initially asked to decrease site funded hours to 5 but since district is no longer providing funding, principal is recommending that we keep the site funding of 10 hours. This will impact other areas of school such as counselor and psychologist. Clarification made by Ms Holerud regarding the reason for emergency meeting. At the last meeting, we discussed reducing EL-IA hours from 20 to 15 with site funding going down to 5 hours. We were not sure if the district was going to fund the 10 hours so members did not feel comfortable making a decision without more information. That would have been a reduction from 20 hours to 5. Principal clarified that we are able to recommend a reduction and add later on but we cannot reduce from what our recommendation is at a later date. Molly Crawford asked about consequences of the site not funding EL-IA position. Principal shared that the responsibility to test students would fall on the site, the language and resource department, and the teachers. Question posed: Would the counselor and the psychologist also need to be paid by the site since the ESSA fund is gone?
