Role	Category	Description	Current Expected Time Commitment
Board or Advisory Board	Board	You will serve a predetermined term on the Board of directors, attending monthly meetings and guiding the future of the organization. Your term will not exceed 4 years.	None beyond attending the monthly meeting for now.
Founder		You want to be involved in everything and play a huge part in getting started and sustaining the organization for many years.	Weekly communication at least. Likely have additional meetings between the main one each month.
Shaper	Volunteer	You show up to meetings and voice your educated opinion in our creation and goals.	3-5 hours per month
Committee Lead	Volunteer	You organize and lead progress in a specific goal or category	10+ hours per month
Committee member	Volunteer	You help with specific pieces of a larger specific goal	6+ hours per month
Member- Pet Professional	Member	Pays to be a part of the organization. Undergoes application and evaluation. Ideally inspections etc.	Complete application process, pay a monthly fee, and complete all requirements to stay active. Expected time after approval is minimal.
