Arrasmith Farm

Arrasmith Farm is a contributing member of Camp Springs Community Businesses in Melbourne, Kentucky.

What do they contribute you ask? Daylilies!

Arrasmith is a family owned flower farm which grows fields of over 650 varieties of daylilies.

They sell their flowers but also allow the community to visit and walk through the fields of large, colorful blooms.



Broken Oaks Farm

Broken Oaks is another Campbell County flower farm, this one located in Alexandria, Kentucky.

The family owned operation grows many different types of flowers which they sell as floral arrangements at the Crestview Hills Town Center farmer's market.
