

5 Days Chongqing - Guizhou Miao Cultural Tour

Day 1 Arrival in Chongqing

-Accommodation: Chongqing

-Transportation: Flight, Private car

Arrive in Chongqing and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, visit the People's Liberation Monument (Jiefangbei), then take a leisurely stroll along Jiefangbei Pedestrian Street. Spend some time exploring the vibrant shopping scene and indulging in the city's famous hotpot dishes.

Day 2 Chongqing - Guiyang

-Accommodation: Guiyang

-Transportation: Private car, High-speed rail

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your day by taking a high-speed rail to Guiyang. On arrival, transfer to Qingyan Ancient Town, a beautifully preserved Ming dynasty town with stone-paved streets, ancient walls, and traditional wooden buildings. Enjoy exploring the town's historical sites and sampling local snacks.

Day 3 Guiyang - Kaili

-Accommodation: Xijiang

-Transportation: Private car

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your day by traveling to Kaili, the gateway to Miao culture. From there, drive to Xijiang Qianhu Miao Village, the largest Miao village in China. Spend the afternoon exploring the village's traditional wooden houses, learning about Miao customs, and watching a cultural performance.

Day 4 Kaili - Langde Miao Village

-Accommodation: Kaili

-Transportation: Private car

After breakfast at the hotel, start your day with a visit to Langde Upper Miao Village, renowned for its well-preserved Miao architecture. Stroll through the village, interact with the local villagers, and enjoy a traditional welcome ceremony. Then, explore the nearby Jidao Miao Village, another beautifully preserved settlement rich in ethnic traditions. In the afternoon, return to Kaili and visit the

Kaili Ethnic Minorities Museum to learn more about the region's diverse cultural heritage.

Day 5 Kaili - Guiyang & Departure

-Transportation: Private car

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your day by heading to Guiyang airport or train station for your departure. If time allows, you can visit the Jiaxiu Pavilion, a symbol of Guiyang, located on the Nanming River. End your tour with wonderful memories of Guizhou's natural beauty and cultural heritage.
