Tell me about your company:

- Explain what your company / organization is and does.
 - We're a competitive fantasy football league of 16 guys who love to be competitive but like to joke around and give each other shit.
- What attributes of your business / organization would you like your logo to reflect?
 - I'd like our logo to reflect the fun and competitive nature of the league. If you could somehow
 incorporate the fact that there are 16 teams in the league (16 stars or something else more
 creative than that) that would be much appreciated.

Goals and Objectives:

- What do you want to happen as a result of this project?
 - I want a logo we can use on our league fantasy football home page, our facebook group page, and potentially to be used on t-shirts or other various items.

Describe what you want designed:

- Describe your aims and requirements in detail here the more specific, the better. Tell the designers what is required, but also let them know where they're free to be creative.
 - o No requirements whatsoever. I welcome as much creativity as possible.
- What key pieces of information / copy need to be included?
 - Anything that helps strongly indicate an association to the sport of American Football or anything that is commonly associated with Masculinity or American Football. (i.e. Beer, Power Tools, Chicken Wings, etc.)
- Include any images, sketches, or documents that may be helpful.

 - White: Purity, Healing, Perfection, Clean, Virtue
 - Blue: Knowledge, Trust, Tranquility, Calm, Peace, Cool
 - Black: Fear, Secrecy, Formal, Luxury
 - Purple: Royalty, Wisdom, Spirituality, Imagination
 - Orange: Creativity, Invigoration, Unique, Stimulation
 - Gray: Balance, Sophistication, Neutrality, Uncommitted

Your company name in a stylised type/font becomes the logo.




Pictoral mark
