Algorithms are step-by-step instructions that computers or other IT systems work with. Computers follow these instructions to complete a task, detailing each step.

An example: what do I do to go to school in the morning?

1. Stand up
2. have a shower
3. Hear the school bell
4. Packing the school bag
5. Have breakfast
6. Go to the train
7. Get off at the correct stop
8. Go to the school building
9. Go to the right classroom.
10. Learn carefully
