 - We should purposefully choose the practices using the IB Philosophy and School Context
 - “Positively impact student learning experiences.”
 - IB would rather have us utilize the PDP based on our school’s actual needs, rather than “ticking a box” at the end of the 5-year eval process
 - We should not get hung up on following the PDP template provided by IB, but instead should make the PDP meaningful for us, aligned with District standards, etc.
 - Reflection is ongoing throughout the process.
 - Planning → Implementation & Analysis → Understanding and Application
 - Development Planning — Continuous, focused improvement

- Should have multiple PDPs throughout the 5-year review cycle
- All resources are found on the PRC under “Standards and practices”.
 - → Examples of PDPs are now available!
 - Annotated with feedback about successes and room for growth on the PDPs
- The PDP should not fall upon the Coordinator to create/manage, but should involve student, parent, administrator, etc., input and involvement.
