Course Description:

This course focuses on design in three dimensions, with emphasis of form and space. Students explore sculpture using a variety of materials including clay, wire, plaster, papier-mâché, linoleum blocks and other found objects. This course also includes a study of historical and contemporary production of three-dimensional art, as well as its cultural significance and implications in society. Individually, students analyze and select their own artistic work for presentation. Collaboratively, they curate an exhibit of the class' work at the end of the year.
