

Student Internship Program 2022

What: A paid internship to help elect Brooke Lierman as Maryland's first woman Comptroller and to learn about how campaigns work! Learn about Brooke at <u>BrookeLierman.com</u>. While school is in session, interns will aim for ~8 hours per week. After the semester ends, interns will have the opportunity to increase their weekly hours.

Who: Seeking students who have an enthusiasm for civic life, liberal politics, and are interested in learning new skills and meeting new people! No prior political experience is needed.

When:

Start date: March 15th although we are flexible and interns may be able to start sooner or later which can be worked out on an individual basis

End date: June 28th (option to extend service if Brooke is successful in the primary)

Goal is at least 8 hours per week with schedule flexibility.

Pay:

- Interns will be paid \$15 per hour and be expected to work at least 8 hours per week
- Interns will have the opportunity to work additional hours should their schedule allow

Virtual or in-person: The internship will have virtual and in-person components. Students will be able to participate in this internship regardless of location.

Why: Because we need your help to ensure that Brooke is elected as our next Comptroller! Brooke will focus on solving the many challenges on income-based issues facing Maryland communities, families, and small businesses. She will work to unlock the potential that exists in this state but which is out of reach for so many!

The fine print:

- You will be a lead for direct voter contact
- You will help amplify the campaign's message via social media, events, and recruitment
- You will help plan, find and execute campaign events
- You will learn how to network with activists in your area
- You will learn how to use VAN VoteBuilder– upon which all Democratic campaigns rely. You will help input data, etc.
- You will interact with voters at events around the state and contact voters in key areas around the state (including by phone, canvass, and text)

- You will be involved in program planning and brainstorming and input will be welcome on any work of the campaign
- Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive a letter of recommendation and a member of the campaign will be happy to serve as a reference for future opportunities
