Prairie Point 7th & 8th Grade Girls Basketball 2020-2021 Season

Practice will focus on learning and refining sport-specific skills, team building, growth in ability and athleticism, as well as, intramural competition between participants

- Due to limited gym space, practices will be in the morning before school or after school. Morning practices will be from times posted on the calendar. After school practices are from 3:00-4:30 pm. There will be no practice on game days.
- **Athletes should not attend school or activities when they are sick. If awaiting test results, do not attend school or practice.**
- Athletes will attend practice **ONLY** on days when they are also in attendance for their cohort at school.
- Masks must be worn at all times unless engaged in strenuous performance type play.
- Equipment will be sanitized by coaching staff before and after each practice
- We encourage athletes to bring their own hand sanitizer and use throughout practices.
- Point athletes will be allowed to use Point locker rooms to dress out for practice and games. No personal belongings will be allowed to be stored in the locker rooms, everything must be taken with the athlete to their respective practice site.
 - o Small groups of athletes will have access to the locker room at a time
 - o Athletes must socially distance and keep face masks on
 - o Coaches will be supervising athletes
- Athletes must provide their own water bottles for practice. We will have access to water refill stations.
- Away games at Iowa City schools will not start until 4:15. Iowa City schools will not let any students/spectators into the building until after 4:00 pm.

Visitor, Volunteers, Field Trips and Student Travel

- No spectators are permitted at practices, scrimmages, dress rehearsals, etc.
- To adhere to COVID protocols, we are limiting spectators to only parents of the athlete. 1 spectator wristband per parent will be provided to the student for the entire season. This wristband will allow entry into all home and away games. The wristband does not need to be worn, but simply held on to and shown when entering the building.

Spectators:

- Masks are required for all games.
- Accept personal responsibility for following public health guidelines
- Practice safe social distancing (limit group to single households). Stay home if you show signs or symptoms or if you have been in contact with someone with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days. If awaiting test results, do not attend events.
- Spectators not following guidelines will be asked to leave.

Away Game Transportation Not Provided

Currently, athletics does not have access to transportation after school, so we will need parents/guardians to transport the players to away games. It is our hope that some parents will be able to carpool and help get all of our players to the games. We would like anyone who has Class B CDL with passenger and school bus endorsements to please contact Andrew Davis. This could provide transportation for some teams and ease the need for parents/guardians to provide transportation.

All 7th & 8th grade athletes will need to have a completed sports [Physical Form](#), Concussion and Informed Consent Form.

COVID REPORTING & CONTACT TRACING: EXTRA- AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students and staff are expected to immediately report any confirmed or potential COVID-19 cases to the school activities director and building principal. The activities director / principal will then report the case to the school nurse and District Health Supervisor. If a student or staff member participating in (or sponsoring) a co-curricular or extra-curricular activity tests positive for COVID-19, the following steps will be taken:

- The activity will immediately be suspended and contact tracing will start
- The activity may be suspended until contact tracing is completed
- During the contact tracing period, all students and staff may have to quarantine and may not be allowed to attend school, in addition to other school/district activities or events
- The contact tracing process will begin as soon as possible
- Once contact tracing is completed and the District provides clearance, the Activity may resume. Students and staff not identified as close contacts may resume participation in activities and attendance at school.

Students and staff that are identified as being in close contact with the individual testing positive must follow quarantine guidance. The student return date will be communicated to the students and their families by a district representative.

We understand that the circumstances will cause some inconveniences, however; we feel this plan can provide a positive experience for our students/athletes. We appreciate and thank you for your flexibility and understanding during these unprecedented times.
